## **Japanese Forces**

#### Japanese Special Rules:

Military Swords (Gunto): The Officers in the Japanese forces carried Katanas, often ancient family heirlooms passed down through the generations from their Samurai ancestors. Japanese Officers equipped with a Katana gain an additional 'shot' when Point Shooting during Close Quarters Battle.

Code of Honour: The Japanese believed that it was a dishonour not to due for their country and Emperor. Surrender was not an option, and suicidal charges were common. As such, all Japanese units have the Fanatics special rule.

### **Japanese Standard Infantry Company**

**Company HQ:** As with many aspects of Japanese military organisation, there are conflicting reports, so I have chosen to take the most commonly reported organisation for this list. It is noted in some reports that the Company HQ's runners were taken from the infantry sections; one man from each section. In the same reports, it is also indicated that the NCOs for Ordnance, Supply and Liaison are actually the NCOs from the HQ sections of the Rifle Platoons.

**Platoon HQ:** Platoon HQs for the Japanese were very small, and may have even only consisted of a single Officer, with their NCO attached to the Company HQ.
